- D. **Connections** - (5 pts)
  - 1. Standards written out

- E. **Resources needed to teach lesson** - (3pts)
- F. **Procedures** - (15pts)
- G. **Assessment** - (5 pts)
- H. **Reflections** - (5 pts)
  - 1. What went well
  - 2. What will you change
- I. **Impact on the awareness of diversity on lesson plan** - (10 pts)
- J. **Teachability** - (10 pts)
