

Targeted Dates

Council shall set the school's yearly delivery targets for eliminating any achievement gaps	October 1
Council shall review the data & revise the School Improvement Plan to include the school's delivery targets, strategies, activities, & a time schedule calculated to eliminate the achievement gap among various groups of students	90 days after public release as prescribed in the NCLB waiver
KDE must provide the schools and school districts data on its students' performance based on the state assessment program	Public release by November 1 [KRS 158.649(2)]
School districts are to submit to KDE training verification for each council member	November 1
Schools receive tentative <u>Staff Allocations</u> based on school board policy	March 1
Schools receive tentative <u>Instructional Fund Allocations</u> based on average daily attendance (ADA) for the previous year multiplied by a fixed amount per pupil	March 1
Schools receive final <u>Staff Allocations</u>	May 1
Schools receive final allocation for <u>Instructional Funds</u>	May 1
Schools may request from the school board <u>Remaining Funds</u> left over after district-wide expenses, certified & classified allocations & minimum allocation to councils	May 30
<u>Professional Development Funds</u> to support activities which develop knowledge & skills to move students toward college & career readiness	Within 30 days of notification from KDE.
<u>Textbook Funds</u> which can be used for instructional materials for each P-8 school based on average daily attendance	When state budget is set.
<u>Extended School Services Funds</u> for students who need additional time to reach state standards; based on average daily attendance	When state budget is set.
