

## 2018-2019 Report to the Delegate Assembly: Classroom Management Training- formerly Kentucky Teacher Internship Program (KTIP)

Due to the changes in the KTIP program KEA replaced our former KTIP training with our Classroom Management Training. Each KEA district scheduled Classroom Management Training and invited their new educators to attend. There were 15 trainings scheduled, and we received the final data for 9 of those. The following data is based upon the data received.

We were able to reach 150 new educators during these trainings.

We had a connection with 67 potential members and 83 members during our trainings.

As this work progresses it is our intent to make a personal connection to all individuals that attended a Classroom Management Session and personally invite them to attend Part II of this training that includes specific Strategies designed for Elementary, Middle, and High School levels. These trainings will take place in KEA Districts and/or our annual Let's TALK Conference.

We have also gained access to many Micro-credential opportunities through NEA and have started to share these with local presidents, district presidents, and school PD Coordinators as possible to help school districts and locals support their new educators. Moving forward each attendee will be invited to attend a short virtual training concerning Micro-credentials and how they can use them to help enhance their own Professional Learning within their classroom.
