The MOVE (Membership, Organizing, Visibility, and Engagement) Committee had another productive year. During the All Committee Weekend meeting, in September 2018, the committee members elected **Tyler Watts** (UKREA District) as the Chair. As required by the KEA Constitution, Article VI, B-6.2(b)(6), officers of this standing committee are elected annually.
