Yesterday, Frankfort was full of excitement and celebration as our Commonwealth inaugurated our 61<sup>st</sup> Governor. Public school educators played a central role during all the activities of the day. More than 200 educators across Kentucky dressed in red an led the inaugural parade down Capital Avenue as Grand Marshals.

The procession of educators was led by Erin Ball, 2019 Valvoline Kentucky Teacher of the Year, Matthew Powell, 2019 NEA Education Support Professional of the Year, and 2019 Kentucky Teacher Hall of Fame inductee and retired educator Nancy Duncan. In addition to serving as Grand Marshals, educators served as emcees during the swearing-in ceremony.

# KEA Statewide Officer Elections

Delegates at the 2020 KEA Delegate Assembly will elect three statewide officers. Any eligible KEA member may be nominated for the open seats. The officers to be elected this year are:

- KEA Ethnic Minority Director at Large (Seat 1) Term begins July 1, 2020 and ends June 30, 2023
- KEA Ethnic Minority Director at Large (Seat 2) -Unexpired term begins on date of election and ends June 30, 2021
- KEA State Director to the NEA Board (Seat 1)\* Term begins September 1, 2020 and ends August 31, 2023. \*Note that all candidates must have been a member of KEA/NEA for two years immediately preceding the election.

#### 2020 NEA Represenative Assembly Delegate Nominations

The 2020 NEA Representative Assembly will be held in Atlanta on July 2-6. Any active member of KEA is eligible to run as a state delegate and may self-nominate by completing and submitting the <u>NEA Representative Assembly Delegate</u> <u>Nomination form at this link</u>.

Forms must be submitted to KEA by 5 p.m. eastern on Wednesday, January 15, 2020. Forms may be emailed to <u>CCC@kea.org</u>, faxed to 502-227-9002, or mailed to KEA, 401 Capitol Avenue, Frankfort, KY 40601. No other means of submission will be allowed. Late nomination forms will not be accepted.

<u>Statewide delegates are elected regionally</u>. The region in which you are elected and in which you can vote is based on the county where you work.
