Last week, the governor called the Kentucky General Assembly into Special Session to act on the Quasi-Governmental Agency Pension plan. Although KEA does not have members in these impacted groups, KEA is a member of the Kentucky Public Pension Coalition that supports ALL public servants who participate in one of Kentucky's multiple pension systems.

KEA stands in solidarity with our fellow public servants. KEA leadership, members (both active and retired), and staff have been actively monitoring events in the House and Senate chambers and have attended committee meetings throughout the session.
