On Wednesday and Thursday we held rallies outside the Capitol Annex and received local, state, and even national media attention. The members of the House and Senate Conference Committee were appointed to hash out a final version of a state budget. You can find a list of the committee members <u>here</u>. They met today to review the items they agreed upon and the ones that they want to continue to discuss. The group also went through <u>HB 366</u>, the revenue bill. We expect this committee to meet again on Monday, March 26th.

I also want to address some rumors going around social media and email threads about KEA activities. It is KEA's position that we welcome anyone that wants to join our efforts to fight for the protection of our public schools. This includes members of other organizations.
