What makes the KY Rank Advancement Academy different from other CEO options?

After the completion of the WKU Research course, each Academy plan is tailored to the individual educator. You will select twelve (12) microcredentials that directly connect to your individual needs outlined in your Professional Growth Plan. This isn't about doing "more" work, it is about identifying the areas you need to grow in and supporting you as you address those needs and ultimately become a better educator.

What are Micro-credentials?

Micro-Credentials are job embedded professional learning that is competency based. They require the educator to capture evidence and demonstrate competency in a specific skill via classroom practice. The process unfolds over several days or weeks and takes an average of 15 clock hours to complete. Micro-credentials allow educators the opportunity for more relevant and meaningful learning.

What makes NEA/KEA Micro-credentials different from others?

Micro-credentials are not a new concept. Many states have used them for years as part of continuing education. However, NEA Micro-credentials are unique. They are created and evaluated by practicing educators and content experts from across the country who assess each submission against a set of competency indicators and provide feedback on the submitted evidence.

IS THERE A TIME LIMIT TO USE MY GRAD CREDIT?

YES! You must use your 12 hours of prior learning credit as graduate credit as WKU within two (2) years of completing the KY Rank Advancement Academy.



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
